7. Sistema y características de la evaluación

Regular, active, constructive attendance of the course will be taken into account. Each student will produce an essay and will present it to the others participants. Optionally and in exceptional circumstances, a written examination may take place to complement the evaluation. The final note for a student attending regularly the course will result from:

-Attendance and active participation, including task-solving: 30%.-Essay (written submission + plenary presentation of an essay: 70%.

In case of no attendance to the classes, the grade will result of final written examination and the **submission to the teacher via email, prior to the exam date, of a 10-12-page essay on one of the above stated topics in the programme, with personal research and conclusions.**

Further details will be transmitted and discussed during the course, in order to customize course design to the participants.
